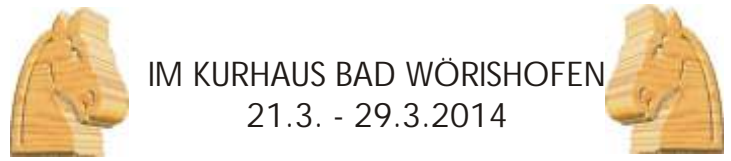
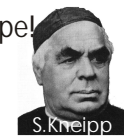


# 30. International ChessOrg Festival Bad Wörishofen

Open and Seniors tournament



The city of Bad Wörishofen with its charming hotels and restaurants together with ChessOrg, invite chess players from all over the world to the 30. Schachfestival. The Seniors' tournament is for women starting from 50 years, men from 60 years.

The tournaments are played in 9 rounds Swiss System. Time control after 2 hours and 40 moves, plus 1 hour per player to the end. The tournaments are DWZ and Elo rated. Title norms can be achieved. Many GMs and IMs are already on the list for this year's edition.
